Sporting Success

This autumn term has also been busy with sporting fixtures for our children in Key Stage Two. They have continued to be very successful in sporting events and have been awarded:

- 2nd place in the Sir Thomas Wharton Pyramid Year 4 Mini Golden Boot Football event
- 1st place in the Sir Thomas Wharton Pyramid Year 5 & 6 Tag Rugby event
- 1st place in the Sir Thomas Wharton Pyramid Year 5 Netball event
- 1st place in the Year 6 Doncaster Dodgeball Finals and have now qualified for the South Yorkshire Dodgeball Finals
- 2nd place in the Year 5 Doncaster Dodgeball finals
- 1st place in the Year 5 & 6 Doncaster Athletics qualifiers and have now qualified for the Doncaster Finals.

Household Support Fund

We appreciate the financial pressure all households are facing at the present time. Doncaster Council have access to funds to award a single payment for food and energy to all

Doncaster households in receipt of:

- housing benefit,
- local council tax reduction,
- universal credit which includes the housing element or
- means-tested free school meals.

The one-off payment will be based on how many people are in your household as follows:

- £130 payment to households with 1 dependent child;
- £190 payment to households with 2 dependent children;
- £250 payment to households with 3 dependent children;
- £310 payment to households with more than 3 dependent children.

This single payment replaces the previous arrangement where schools issued vouchers for children on means-tested free school meals for each of the school holidays.
