EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE CURRICULUM

There are 7 areas of learning within the Early Years Curriculum

- 2. Physical Development
- 3. Communication and Language
- 4. Literacy
- 5. Mathematics
- 6. Understanding the World
- 7. Expressive Arts and Design







KEY PERSON

- Your child will be allocated a <u>Key Person</u> Mrs Williams or Mrs Layhe
- The Key Person will support your child within the FS1 setting
- You will be invited to two Open Evenings, one in the first term and one in the second term, to discuss your child's progress
- You will be invited to Enterprise Events and Parent Workshops

DAILY ROUTINE

Morning session starts at **8.45am – 11.45am.**

Afternoon session starts at 12.30pm – 3.30pm

- Enter and leave FS1 through the same door
- Your child will be put into a colour team red, yellow, blue and green
- Your child will be encouraged to organise their own belongings independently – locate their personalised hook to hang their coat on, place their water bottle and book bag in an allocated box







Daily Routine

- Organisation of belongings
- Welcome song, register, calendar
- Daily physical session in the hall
- An adult directed learning task
- Snack time (register for milk on the coolmilk website)
- Child initiated learning
- Daily story session
- Organisation for home time

ASSESSMENT

- Assessments are carried out continuously throughout the year
- You will be invited to attend two Open Evenings during the year
- You will receive an end of year report in the summer term
- Your child will have books and folders which illustrates their learning journey throughout the year

WAYS TO HELP PREPARE YOUR CHILD FOR FOUNDATION 1

- Taking shoes / coats / jumpers / cardigan off and putting them back on. Putting clothes inside out and practising putting them the correct way
- Accessing the toilet independently being able to pull trousers and tights up and down, sitting on the toilet, care for their own hygiene when at the toilet
- Supporting them to independently wash their hands
- Giving them experiences of peeling and eating fruit in its full form, as we do provide fruit each day at snack time
- Please <u>name</u> all their belongings: uniform, shoes, bags, water bottle, wellingtons
