The first half-term of 2024 is almost coming to a close, but what a lot of excitement has been had in school over the last 5 weeks ... we have:

- Hosted 10 parent sessions where we have invited parents/carers in every year group to support/share their child's learning in class,
- Offered 450 appointments for parent/carer pupil progress meetings,
- Taken 180 children on school visits to 3 off-site locations,
- Two visitors have led the learning of children in class about being safe on social media,
- ... And last but not least our children have performed two $Y 3 / 4 / 5$ productions on $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ February 2024, involving 180 cast members, for 360 audience members
What a fantastic array of enrichment experiences for our children in a short half-term of 5 weeks!

Thank you to everyone who has attended a Parent/Carer Progress meeting over this half-term. We always aim for $100 \%$ contact and are very close at $97 \%$ contact. If you haven't been able to meet your child's class teacher to discuss your child's attainment and progress, please contact the school office on 01302852200 to make an appointment.

## Attendance \& Punctuality

At your Parent/Carers Progress meeting, the class teacher will have shared with you any concerns about your child's attendance. We aim for every child to have an attendance of $97 \%$ and above. Lateness and absenteeism can have a detrimental effect on both a child's social and emotional well-
 being, as well as their attainment and progress.

The attendance of every child is important and we aim to ensure that every child knows that their presence is valued and they are missed when they are absent or late arriving at school. We have a responsibility to encourage and facilitate good attendance and are currently in the process of sending letters to families, where attendance is of concern. We aim to work with all families to overcome any barriers to their child's attendance
in a supportive process where we collaboratively work towards common goals to improve the attendance for their child, and we have had some great success stories for the families as a whole.

In our Friday assemblies, we present an attendance award to the class with the highest attendance for the previous week - the children are always excited to receive the award and the children are always eager to find out who has received the award each week. They are all on board with our mission to improve attendance and know we would love the attendance of class to be above $97 \%$.

A special well done to 4VL, who have a half-yearly attendance to date of $96 \%$ and above, and to 2AS, 5AA and 6HA, who are very close - keep up the good work!
We are also seeing several children regularly arriving late to school. This can cause several difficulties for these children, as they have often missed the initial input to the learning and have not had the same socialisation time coming into the classroom as their peers.

## Every minute counts! (Figures below are calculated over a school year)

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    5 minutes late each day = 2.75 days of lost learning time
10 minutes late each day = 5.5 days of lost learning time
15 minutes late each day = 8.25 days of lost learning time
20 minutes late each day = 11 days of lost learning time
30 minutes late each day = 16.5 days of lost learning time
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If a child's attendance is $96 \%$ this means that they have missed 7.8 school days during the year - that is almost 8 days of lost learning time If a child's attendance is $94 \%$ this means that they have missed 11.7 school days during the year - that is almost 12 days of lost learning time.
If a child's attendance is $92 \%$ this means that they have missed 15.6 school days during the year - that is more than 3 weeks of lost learning time.

If your child's attendance is $90 \%$ or below, they are identified by the Department for Education as a Persistent Absentee and this data is collected by the Local Authority and the Department for Education.

If a child's attendance is $90 \%$ this means that they have missed 19.5 school days during the year - that is almost 4 weeks of lost learning time.
If a child's attendance is $88 \%$ this means that they have missed 23.4 school days during the year - that is almost 5 weeks of lost learning time.
If a child's attendance is $86 \%$ this means that they have missed 27.3 school days during the year -that is almost 6 weeks of lost learning time.
If a child's attendance is $84 \%$ this means that they have missed 31.2 school days during the year - that is more than 6 weeks of lost learning time.
If a child's attendance is $82 \%$ this means that they have missed 35.1 school days during the year - that is more than 7 weeks of lost learning time.
If a child's attendance is $80 \%$ this means that they have missed 39 school days during the year - that is almost 8 weeks of lost learning time.

We continue to recruit staff to support our school and the learning of our children. Many of you may have already met or spoken to Mrs Nagib who has joined \#TeamWarmsworth this year and we are looking forward to welcoming Mrs Khan to the administration team very shortly too. Mr MacPhee has also joined our staffing team this term as our School Business Manager, ahead of Mrs Hilling's retirement at the end of March 2024. Two more support staff have also joined our school this half-term, to meet the needs of some of our children, Mrs Marshall and Ms Warnar.

We are saying our sad goodbyes to Mrs Shaw on Friday, as she explores flexible teaching options in other schools - Mrs Shaw is one of the longest serving members of staff at Warmsworth Primary School, having completed 22 years since she started teaching at the school in November 2001. I am sure everyone will join me, including children and parents past and present, in thanking Mrs Shaw for all her hard work and dedication to support the children of Warmsworth and the surrounding areas. We have calculated that in those 22 years, Mrs Shaw has potentially taught over 660 children at our school - what an achievement and influence she has had over so many lives. We will be welcoming Mrs Hartley to teach in year 2 after the half-term break and the children in Mrs Shaw's class have already spent 2 days with her in class.

Thank you for your continued support, we are looking forward to a fantastic 2024 at Warmsworth Primary School!
