Since our last newsletter, parents and friends of our children in Key Stage Two have raised an enormous £1635.254 from their Skipathon, which has funded first-aid training for all children in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 and will also support further activities during the year – thank you everyone for such generous sponsorship!

Our celebration of reading day, to acknowledge World Book Day, was very well supported and our new Research Hub is taking shape, as we are moving our school library into our Computing Suite to enable our children to access the area independently. We are hoping to set up an Amazon 'Wish-list' in the future, should any of our school community wish to donate any books to our Research Hub.

School Meals Prince Increase

As you are aware, the cost of food has increased in the last couple of years and we have been trying hard to negotiate a new deal with our school meals provider. Despite strong negotiations, the price of a school meal after the Easter break will rise to £2.85 per day (£14.25 per week) and we are having to move to one hall for the schools meals service to keep costs down. This means that after the Easter holidays, all children having a school meal (hot dinner, jacked potatoes or school sandwiches) will eat their lunch in the main KS2 hall and all children bringing their home-packed lunch will eat their lunch in the lower school hall.
