School Meals

Mrs Parr, our school cook, and her team have been very busy this term preparing delicious themed meals. Last week they prepared a Chinese New Year feast for those taking a hot meal, and this week she has prepared a special Valentine's themed meal. Mrs Parr has more themed days planned for the rest of the school year - thank you Mrs Parr and team! If your child would like to start having school meals, please contact the school office.

We have been working very closely with the Doncaster School Meals Service, but due to rising food costs etc, the cost of a school meal from 1^{st} April 2022 will be £2.59 per day, meaning a weekly cost of £12.95. Please also note that we have also been informed that any meals that are ordered and not cancelled by 10.30am will be charged to ParentPay, even if the meal isn't taken. To ensure this charge is not made, if you need to take your child to a medical appointment in the morning, please ensure the office are informed of an intended return time and whether or not you wish for your child to have a school meal on their return.

Covid Update

I am delighted to say that the number of Covid cases in children and staff in school has dropped dramatically over the last 2 weeks and almost all have retuned back to school. Thank you for all your support with the increased measures we put in as part of our Outbreak Plans. We are hoping to return more back to 'normality' after the half term break, and are planning on resuming our parent sessions back in school, but we will need to monitor any cases carefully to keep everyone as safe as possible.

School Vision and Values

After the half term break, we will be relaunching our school vision and values with the children.

Our New Website and App

Our long awaited new website is due to go live over the half-term break and we can't wait for you all to see it. Following parent feedback, we decided to update our communication app too. Our website will still be found at the same web address:

However, as we have changed website provider, our current School Jotter App will no longer be in use. Instead, you will need to download the School Spider App (for all information please see the attached information sheet.)

In order to make communication between school and home as effective as possible, all our communication will be via the School Spider App; it will replace both the School Jotter App and text messaging system.

The School Spider App is free to download. If you wish, it may be personalised and tailored to specific year groups and alerts turned on to direct you to new posts. Staff will be adding weekly posts onto the year group pages to share the children's learning and achievements each week - we can't wait to show you!

To access the App, you must share your email address with us. For each child you can provide up to 4 email addresses that you would like to have access to the App – this means that multiple parents and wider family members, such as grandparents, can also keep better informed via the App. If you haven't completed the Google Form or supplied us with an email address in an alternative way, please complete the Google Form on our website or send your child's name, class, your name, relationship to your child and email address to: secretary@warmsworthschool.co.uk


